

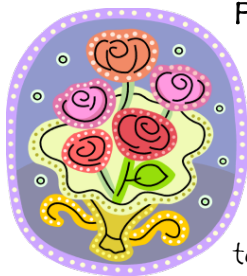

Kindergarten. To the preschoolers who will be back, have a great summer and we will see you in the fall.

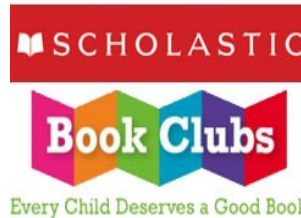

Skills for Kindergarteners:

Over the Summer preschoolers moving on to Kindergarten should be working on recognizing letters and numbers. Also, following directions without needing repetition of the directions will help. Lastly, writing their names correctly with the first letter upper case and the rest lower case.

Skills for Returning Preschoolers: Over the Summer first year preschoolers should be working on their self-help skills (dressing selves, washing hands correctly, etc.). Also, recognizing colors and shapes would help with their second year of preschool. Lastly, developing and building strength with fine and gross motor skills.

As children play they are developing the cognitive, socio-emotional and physical skills they will need to take them into a successful adulthood.

They are developing their curiosity, problem solving, intentionality, flexibility, and verbal & non verbal skills.

Socio-emotionally they are developing their emotional intelligence - learning confidence, cooperation, negotiation, sharing, empathy and how to communicate appropriately.

Physically their fine motor and gross motor skills are being practised and developed.
